

2013 AAU National Championship

The Aurora flyers track club returned from the AAU National Championship in Ypsilanti, Michigan where the Flyers had an outstanding showing. The club earned 33 medals and had 6 national champions!

Outstanding performances included the following:

The 11-12 girls 4 x 800 finished 8th with a time of 10.56. Members included Alexandra Bernard, Naperville, Alyssa Bondurantt, Aurora, Gabrielle Horton, Evanston, and McKenna Robinson, Naperville.

The 15-16 girls 4 x 800 relay finished 8th with a time of 10.11. The group included Olodde Ayoola, Frankford, Rachael Lau, Plainfield, Kathleen Sheehan, Naperville, and Keydal Wallace, Frankford.

The 15-16 girls 4 x 100 relay placed 3rd with a time of 48.47. Members were Alexis Brooks, Bolingbrook, Antoninette Broughton, Homewood, Hannah Cohn, Olymipa Fields, and Brion Hughes, Aurora.

15-16 4 x 400 meter relay took 3rd with a time of 3.58. They were Anna Laudizo, Plainfield, Charlyncia Stennis, Bolingbrook, Keydal Wallace, Frankford, and Broin Hufges, Aurora.

17-18 girls 4 x 400 meter relay finished 1st with a time of 3.46. Girls included Ashley Frouch, New Hamsire, Jenna Moddy, Plainfield, Janiel Rogers, Moonki and Jordan Shead, St. Charles.

In the 11-12 girls Pentathlon, Aumtum Richmond, Naperville, finished 2nd with 2476 points and 2nd in the 80 meter hurdles with a time of 13.2.

In the girls 17-18 Heptathlon, Maya Neal took 2nd with 4464 points, Peyton Wade, Naperville, took 4th with 4450 points and 1st in the high jump at 5'06.

Rachael Lau, Plainfield, captured 1st in the 15-16 girls Steeple Chase with a time of 10.20 and 1st in the 3000 meters.

In the 13-14 girls discus, Courney Morgan, Aurora, placed 1st with a throw of 126' and also captured 1st in the shot put with a throw of 38.4.

In the 17-18 girls 400 meters, Jenna Moddy, Plainfield, placed 6th with a time of 56.0. Ashley Fouch, New Hampshire, placed 1st with a time of 55.97.

In the 13-14 boys 400 meter, Jaqurere Williams won 5th place with a time of 52.5.

The 13-14 girls 4 x 100 relay was 9th missing by 0.4 with time of 49.4. Girls included Alecandrina Henderson, Plainfield, Seleena Tucker, Plainfield, Edoise Omoike.Lisle, and Hannah Schlaman, Batavia.
